We manufacture a wide variety of poly bags and sheeting, shrink bags and shrink films, printed bags and films, and a multitude of other custom bags and films.



Our Poly bags are used as drum, bin and box liners in many different industries including but certainly not limited to the janitorial /sanitation, food service, agriculture, manufacturing sector and anywhere else as it is needed. Our custom bags are also used to help protect items during the shipping of many

retail products from the manufacturers to retail stores. From TV's to shirts, most anything you've purchased in a retail store was shipped in a box, but protected with a bag.



Our machinable and shrink films are used in the garment industry, food packaging industry, toy industry, agricultural sector and many, many other industries. For example, our films have been used for unitizing bottled beverages in cases to wrapping and protecting mattresses and furniture for shipment to retail stores.
